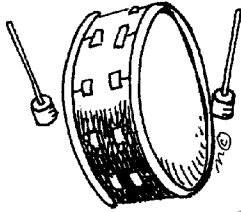


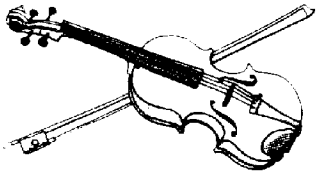
# SoundPlay

Utilizing children's ability to learn through play, we will investigate the nature of sound while learning musical concepts with traditional instruments such as keyboards, voice and percussion, as well as technologically-mediated instruments such as microphones and samplers.

Classically-trained, experimentally-bent musician and educator Marielle V. Jakobsons earned her MFA in Electronic Music and Recording Media from Mills College, Oakland, her BA in Piano Performance and Biology from the Cleveland Institute of Music and Case Western Reserve University. She has studied violin with Yoko Moore (assistant concertmaster of the Cleveland Orchestra), piano with Anita Pontremoli, and improvisation with Fred Frith.

With over eight years experience in music education, she offers private lessons and group courses to students of all ages combining traditional training with flexibility, experimentalism and improvisation. This fall, she is a Visiting Professor at San Francisco State University teaching the course Experimental Sound. Her music may be heard in solo shows and installations, with Agnes Szlag as the electroacoustic pop duo myrmyr, and as electric violinist for the multimedia ensemble TrioMetrik
